Bus Routes:

From West Chester, Exton, and Valley Forge: Take Septa #92N to King of Prussia Plaza, transfer to #139N, and get off at Walnut and Main in Phoenixville.

From Collegeville: Take #93N to Philadelphia Premium Outlets, transfer to #139S, and get off at Nutt and Kimberton Rd. If near Septa #99, your stop is Church and Main.

From West Chester

Take **202 N**

Exit onto **Conestoga Rd/PA-401 E** toward **Frazer**

Turn **left** at **Mill Ln/Sidley Rd**; continue to follow Sidley

Turn **right** at **Phoenixville Pike**

Continue onto **PA-29 N/State Rd**

Turn **left** at **Nutt Rd**

Turn **right** at **Mason St**

Turn **right** onto **Wheatland St**

From Collegeville

Take **PA-29 S**

Continue onto **Bridge**

Turn **right** at **Wheatland St**

From Exton

Take **PA-100 N/N Pottstown Pike**

Turn **right** onto **PA-113 N/E Uwchlan Ave**

Turn **right** at **Nutt Rd**

Turn **left** at **Mason St**

Turn **right** onto **Wheatland St**

From Valley Forge National Park

Take **PA-23 E/W Valley Forge Rd**

Merge onto **US-422** via ramp to **Pottstown**

Take **PA-29 S/Phoenixville exit**

Turn **left** at **PA-29 S/Phoenixville Collegeville Rd**

Continue to follow **PA-29 S**

Continue onto **Bridge St**

Turn **right** at **Wheatland St**
